Hamper Donation

The Parish Council will be donating a hamper to Invicta Valley School for their Easter Raffle - fundraising to improve the children's outdoor learning space.

£500 Donation

The Parish Council will be donating £500.00 to the Kings Hill Foodbank as the councils Big Help Out project - part of the coronation weekend We celebrations. residents encourage wish who may participate to donate to a foodbank.

Sports Park News

£60k Grant Funding

The football club has managed to secure a grant of £60,000 from the Football Foundation with the assistance of TM Active. This was only possible as the club now has long term lease enabling them to secure this investment spread over a six year period for pitch improvements over and above their current standard.

£52k Grant Funding

TM Active has successfully been awarded £52,000 in grant aid to install floodlights on the tennis courts which will secure 35% more playing time in a full year. Legal permissions are currently being sought from Prologis but hopefully these will be in place in the next few months.
