Where and When?

The Kings Hill Community Centre every day 9am-5pm Monday – Friday (and weekends if the centre is open for functions). This is managed by 'The Book Carousel' which shows books currently in the library, so please join the Facebook group to see what we have to borrow before you visit.

2024-2025 Budget Consultation

Each year the Parish Council sets a precept. This is the amount that the parish council adds to the council tax paid by households in the parish, and is the main source of funds for everything the parish council does during the year.

Although the population of the parish is growing and the council will be facing increases in costs due to inflation, the council is hopeful that the precept will remain at £552,847 for the year starting on 1 April 2024. This means that the Parish Council part of your council tax bill should not be any higher than in the current year. The council can do this because it has built up savings over the last few years.

We want to hear from you!

The council will make a <u>final decision</u> about the precept <u>in January 2024</u>. If there is anything you would like the council to consider at that meeting about how much money it should spend, or what it should spend money on, please get in touch by the <u>22nd of December</u>. There has been much interest in a Pump Track and improving the Christmas Lights which the council is investigating.
