Casual Vacancy – Co-option Information Pack

Overview

A **casual vacancy** has arisen on Kings Hill Parish Council. When a seat becomes vacant midterm and is not filled by election, the Council may opt to co-opt a new member. This is an opportunity to represent your community, shape local priorities, and get involved in civic life.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to stand for co-option, you must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, or a citizen of the EU
- Meet at least one of the following:
 - o Registered to vote in Kings Hill
 - Lived in or within 3 miles of Kings Hill for the past 12 months
 - Worked in Kings Hill during the past 12 months
 - o Owned property in Kings Hill for the past 12 months

You are **disqualified** from standing if:

- You are declared bankrupt or are subject to a bankruptcy restrictions order
- You have been convicted of a criminal offence and sentenced to 3+ months imprisonment in the past 5 years (without suspension)
- You are disqualified under election law

What Councillors Do

Parish Councillors play a vital role in representing residents' views and shaping services and projects in the community. Responsibilities include:

- Attending monthly council meetings
- Voting on local issues and budget decisions
- Supporting community initiatives and events
- Engaging with residents and liaising with other local authorities

No prior experience is needed—just a passion for Kings Hill and a willingness to get involved.

Co-option Process

- 1. Submit the **application form** below to the Clerk
- 2. Attend a Parish Council meeting (if shortlisted)
- 3. The Council will vote to co-opt a candidate
